

PROTEST FILING DEADLINES

The usual deadline for filing your protest (having it postmarked if you mail it) is midnight, June 1st.

A different deadline will apply to you if:

- Your notice of appraised value was delivered to you after May 1. Your deadline will be 30 days after the notice delivery date.
 - Your protest concerns a change in use of agricultural, open-space, or timber land. Your deadline will be 30 days after the notice delivery date.
 - The ARB made a change to the appraisal records that adversely affect you and you received notice of the change. Your deadline will be 30 days after the notice delivery date.
 - The appraisal district or the ARB was required by law to send you notice about a property and did not. Your deadline will be 30 days after the notice delivery date.
 - Or, you had good cause for missing the protest filing deadline **(The ARB will determine if good cause exists for missing a deadline. Good cause means that something beyond your control, such as a medical emergency, prevented you from meeting the deadline).**
- **Notice Delivery Date:** The date the notice was mailed.
- **Weekends and Holidays:** If your protest deadline falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or a legal holiday it is postponed until midnight of the next working day.
