

Electronic (eFile) Protest Information Eligibility for Online Protest

Brazos Central Appraisal District will offer Electronic Filing of Notice of Protest to limited number of property owners of residence homesteads beginning in 2013.

If your homesteaded property is eligible, you will have received a Notice of Appraised Value that included a personal identification number (PIN) printed in the top right section. Included will also have been detailed instructions on using the eFile process.

Important points to remember, should you decide to file an electronic protest:

- The reason for the protest must be:
 - Value is Over Market Value; and/or
 - Value is Unequal compared with other similar properties
- Your PIN is case sensitive; enter it exactly as it appears on your notice
- Your PIN will be used as your signature; do not share your login information with anyone else.

As we continue providing eFile capability; availability has been limited, as allowed by law, to a sampling of homesteaded properties. As we gain experience with the new system and develop analytical tools to facilitate the electronic protest process, we anticipate making this feature available to more property types and owners in future years.
